**Frazee Police Department General Order Regarding Officer**  
**Standbys, Business Checks and Requests for Officers**

**Officer Requests at Public/Private Functions:** When an officer is requested to attend a function, the officer should determine the type of function, why their presence is necessary, and the length of time they will be needed. If time permits, approval for the standby should be sought. If there is minimal potential for a breach of the peace, the officer may refuse to act as standby for that function, unless otherwise directed. A repetitive request for an officer's attendance needs to be approved by the Chief. Officers are not to be used as private security officers for any entity unless, that entity has made arrangements with the City to hire an officer off duty. Standby availability will depend on the needs of the City and Police Department availability.

**Business checks and Bar Checks:** Business/Bar checks serve many purposes for the safety of our community and business owners. Business/Bar Checks are encouraged and serve as a good public relations opportunity for the Officers and general public. Business/Bar checks should be limited to a reasonable amount of time.

**Attendance at sporting events and other student functions:** Sporting events and student functions have a greater risk of illegal activity and dangerous situations. Parking lots and other exterior areas where students may gather/hide/vandalize or consume illegal products are high risk areas and should be checked, with the time at any one specific location kept within reason.
